Project-based learning is a mix of choice and responsibility, cognitive concepts and practical activities. Project challenges are within a real-world scenerios.

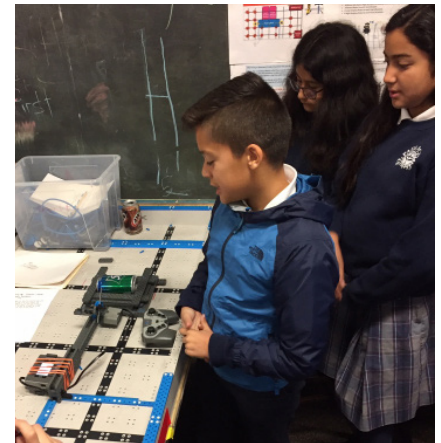
We find that these projects engage students in learning that is creative, purposeful, involve 21st Century skills and that is deep and long-lasting.



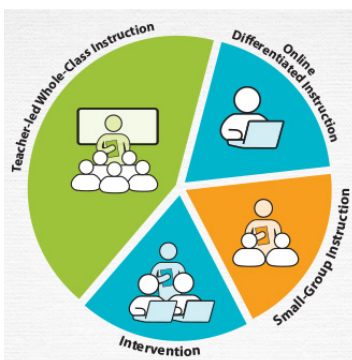
Integrating TECHNOLOGY
